



St. Joseph's Prep Ice Hockey 2006-07 Program Objectives



1. Successfully expand the program to three teams to meet the demand from students who want to play competitive high school hockey.
2. Strengthen and expand the board to create greater participation opportunities for parents in the high school experience of their sons.
3. Create and implement an effective, cost-efficient training and conditioning program to assist the players with their physical development in a safe, structured and supervised manner.
4. Explore ways to improve the scheduling of games; particularly with the aim to reduce the number of late night games on school nights.
5. Introduce a more consistent approach to offensive and defensive strategies and concepts of team play across all teams.
6. Foster a more cohesive, coordinated coaching staff with a focus on regular meetings and cross utilization of coaching expertise wherever possible.
7. Create and implement a fundamental leadership training program to assist the players develop into leadership roles.
8. Expand the development of community service opportunities as part of team-building and individual growth.
9. Continue to foster closer relationships with SJP school officials and to keep them apprised of the program's development.
10. Work to improve the dialogue with league officials and look for ways to work together to solve problems related to SJP's participation.
